 Λ Simply connect the dots and fill in the blanks to fit the mind's image. This puzzle approach, in which we put pieces together to form a diagnosis, works for the majority of suspected aggressive periodontitis patients. However, when we experience presentations that do not have fitting pieces, the diagnosis some times becomes mysterious. This lecture focuses on answers, as well as questions, aimed at helping the clinician to understand the etiology, diagnosis and treatment of Aggressive Periodontitis.

Dr. Alon Frydman is an Assistant Professor of Clinical Dentistry in the Division of Periodontology, Diagnostic Sciences and Dental Hygiene as well as the Division of Restorative Sciences. Dr. Frydman recieved his dental degree from the UCLA school of Dentistry and his specialty certificate from the Advanced Periodontology program at the Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry of USC . GUIDED BONE REGENERATION

If you have a molar you might consider splitting the roots and removing them individually in order to retain as much bone as possible so that you can build up the ridge either for the construction of a bridge or the placement of a dental implant. At that time, bone is placed into the socket, which may be a combination of autogenous bone, cancellous bone, which may be a demineralized freeze-dried allograft. This is then mixed with mineralized bone or BioOss and calcium sulfate. After the above has been mixed, it will be inserted into the socket, which is then covered by one or two membranes of which one will be collagen and the second may be an impermeable membrane such as Tefgen or GBR. The graft is left to heal for approximately 3-4 months before placing an implant.
