ABOUT THE TOPIC

BCT: The Basics

The arrival of Cone-Beam CT technology has revolutionized the way we visualize the maxillofacial complex. The 3rd dimension offered by CBCT imaging allows us to finally visualize structures directly without superimposition or distortion. As a result, CBCT is quickly finding a niche in nearly every dental arena: from implants, tooth impactions, root fractures, TMD, oral pathology, trauma and craniofacial asymmetry. This lecture will provide an overview of the underlying technology involved in CBCT acquisition, review concerns about radiation dose and identify clinical applications for which CBCT is most effective. Various pathologies seen on CBCT will be reviewed, with an emphasis on the importance of critically evaluating the entire imaged volume.

Dr. Mohammed Husain is an Oral and Maxillofacial Radiologist. In January of 2016, he will be joining the UCLA faculty in the section of Oral Radiology as an Assistant Clinical Professor. In 2014, Dr. Husain completed his residency training in Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology at UCLA. Already, he has experience interpreting more than 4000 CBCT scans obtained for a diverse range of clinical indications. He lectures on various topics in oral and maxillofacial radiology, with a special interests in root resorption and CBCT interpretation. He has published in the journal of Oral Surgery, Oral Medicine, Oral Pathology, Oral Radiology (OOOO) on the topic of the intervertebral pneumatocyst. His latest research interest is in the clinical applications of 3-D printing using CBCT imaging data.

••••••• PRACTICE PEARLS ••••••

When treating pediatric patients, it is important to prescribe the right type of radiographs at appropriate intervals based on the individual patient's needs. Over prescribing X-rays exposes patients to unnecessary radiation. Under prescribing puts patients at risk for lesions to progress undetected to advanced stages. In 2012, the ADA and FDA released a guideline entitled, "Dental Radiographic Examinations: Recommendations for Patient Selection and Limiting Radiation Exposure."

The guidelines provide easy to read tables with recommended type of X-rays and intervals based on patient age and caries risk factors. The one size fits all approach, e.g. bitewings on every patient once a year, is no longer the standard of care. Following the guidelines is easy to do and allows the practitioner to make sure that they are not over or under prescribing X-rays. The guidelines can be found at: http://ofp.dds.com/aopearl2


