"Pathology Diagnosis and Management in the Dental Patient: Best Practices for the Oral Health Care Provider!"

Wednesday, November 29, 2017

ABOUT THE TOPIC

This course is designed for oral health care providers, particularly dentists, dental specialists, and dental hygienists, to provide an update in oral pathology and best practices with respect to diagnosis and management of oral lesions. This course is clinically focused to allow immediate translation to daily practice. Common and rare oral conditions ranging from developmental, inflammatory, infectious, and neoplastic etiology will be discussed. Hot topics in oral diagnosis will also be discussed, such as HPV and oral cancer, bisphosphonate patients and dental care, and medicolegal issues in this context.

OUTCOMES: Participants of this course will gain knowledge into the differential diagnosis of clinical and radiographic oral lesions, and how to reach definitive diagnosis. Participants will learn about the management of common oral conditions, and also preventative and follow-up strategies to minimize medicolegal risk and maximize positive patient outcomes.

r. Parish P. Sedghizadeh is an Associate Professor of Clinical Dentistry at the University of Southern California, Herman Ostrow School of Dentistry, and Director of the USC Center for Biofilms. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in biology from UCLA, and his Doctorate of Dental Surgery from USC. After his doctorate, he pursued specialty training in Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology at Ohio State University, where he also attained a Master of Science degree in oral biology, fellowship in the American Academy of Oral and Maxillofacial Pathology, and subsequently board certification. Dr. Sedghizadeh conducts research, publishes, consults, and teaches oral and maxillofacial pathology, radiology, and medicine with an active clinical practice. Dr. Sedghizadeh has over 80 peer-reviewed publications, and his research laboratory, clinical practice, and clinical research projects at USC currently focus on the characterization and treatment of head and neck pathology and microbial biofilm infections, particularly jaw osteomyelitis, peri-implantitis, and osteonecrosis of the jaw where he has developed novel bone-targeted antimicrobial therapeutics.
